ABOUT LOCATION

The story of the Chess Game dates back to 1454 when Marostica belonged to the Venetian Republic.

Two noblemen fell in love with the beautiful Lionora who was the daughter of the Lord of the Marostica's castle. They challenged each other to a duel to win the hand of Lionora. The Lord forbade the encounter. He decided the two rivals should play a chess game and Lionora would take the winner as her husband. The loser would in any case join his family, marrying Oldrada, the younger sister.

This event is repeated today just like the first time, in a framework of sumptuous costumes, multi-color banners, martial parades, exquisite elegance. The show, with over 550 characters, lasts about 2 hours.
