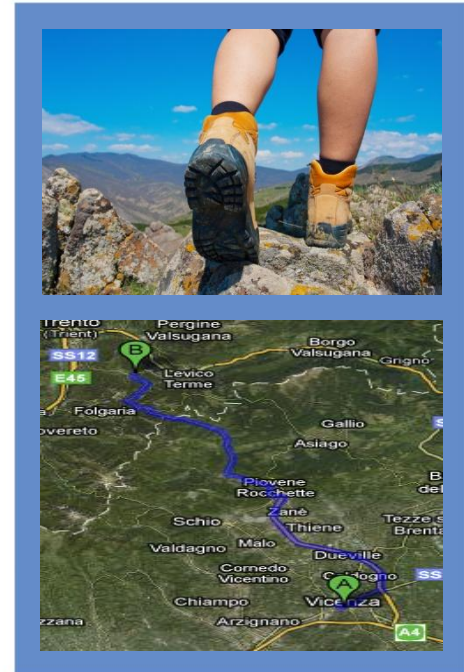
Trip Details:

We will depart from ODR at 8 a.m. for an approximate arrival for 9:30 a.m. and once situated we will begin our hike up the mountain.

This one is a hiking tour of great historic significance, as well as wonderful natural landscape. This was the site of some of the most important battles during the First World War. The *Battle of Mount Ortigara* was fought from 10 to 25 June 1917 between the Italian and Austro-Hungarian armies for possession of Mount Ortigara. **Mount Ortigara** (2,105 m, 6,906 ft) is one of the peaks, about 2,000 meters (6,000 feet) tall in the Asiago Plateau.

Once we've completed the hike we will return to Caserma Ederle for 5 p.m.

8 a.m. – meet and depart from ODR
9:30 a.m. – arrive, park and start our hike
5 p.m. – arrive back to Caserma Ederle
