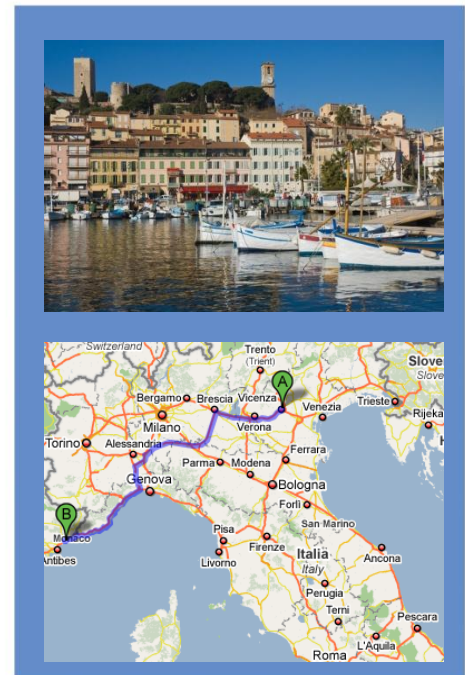

### Location Information

The city of Cannes is located on a large bay on the Mediterranean Sea in the south of France as is best known for the Cannes Film Festival held each spring at the Palais des Festivals et des Congress on Boulevard de la Croisette. While there you can enjoy a stroll along the marina (Quai St. Pierre has the best views) and admire the luxurious yachts and sailboats. Many wealthy Europeans maintain a boat in Cannes, flying in for rest and relaxation.

On a hill overlooking the city of Cannes is the Cannes castle, a location you can reach with a hike to enjoy wonderful views or to visit the Musee de la Castre. The Notre Dame Esperance Church can also be found on the hilltop with stunning views of Cannes France and the Cote d'Azur.

The main shopping street in Cannes is called the Rue d'Antibes and is home to many expensive shops selling designer clothing, furniture and jewelry and catering to the rich and famous. You can also find a beautiful park with flowers, trees and rosebushes at the east end of Plage de la Croisette. Tourists to Cannes can enjoy a leisurely stroll from the Cannes City Hall along the waterfront to this pretty park, located at Square Verdun Roserale. The Casino Palm Beach is located nearby.

After lunch we will continue on to Nice. While there you will have the opportunity to view La Promenade des Anglais (a superb seafront promenade) and the Matisse Museum (a 17<sup>th</sup> century Genoan-style Villa).
