We will depart from the Chapel around 3 a.m. and travel to Munich, arriving around 11 a.m. Once there you will have a chance to enjoy the Oktoberfest activities which include various rides, displays, food and beer. Oktoberfest in Munich is the world's largest fair with 6 million visitors and the highlight of Germany's annual events calendar. Besides it's amazing atmosphere, you'll be able to enjoy delicious Bavarian beer. Over 6 million liters of beer are consumed during every Oktoberfest. This year Oktoberfest takes place from September 19<sup>th</sup> until October 4<sup>th</sup>, and we won't let you miss it! Entry into Oktoberfest is free.

After spending your free time at the fest we will begin our return trip around 6 p.m., arriving back at the chapel around 2 a.m. on October 2.
