ABOUT LOCATION

The Gallerie, 52 Tunnels of Mt. Pasubio was built and used from 1915-1918, to provide lateral lines of communications and supply to the Italian V Corps in the Pasubio area. The Gallerie was needed to quickly move troops and equipment along a generally east west line out of sight and artillery fire of Austrian and Hungarian enemy forces.
