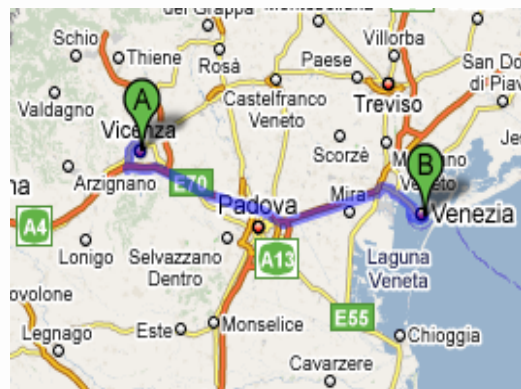
Not included R/T by train to Venice, cost approx. 13 Euro.
