Rimini is one of the most famous seaside resorts in Europe. Sometimes called the "Miami of Europe," Rimini is blessed with a 15 km-long sandy beach, over 1,000 hotels and thousands of bars, restaurants and discos. The first bathing establishment opened here in 1843. Rimini is also the hometown of the famous film director Federico Fellini. It is also a charming city that is rich in roman and renaissance monuments.

Trip details

Day 1: We will arrive in Rimini at approximately 11 a.m. on Friday. You will enjoy free time and after check in, we will walk toward downtown Rimini and discover the different facilities along the Rimini shoreline.

Day 2: Excursion to the Adriatic Coast and beaches of Le Marche. We will visit Ancona, Numana and Sirolo by bus. There will be free time for shopping and sightseeing. Lunch and dinner are not included.

Day 3: After breakfast, it will be time for check-out and you will have free time until our departure at 1:30 p.m.
